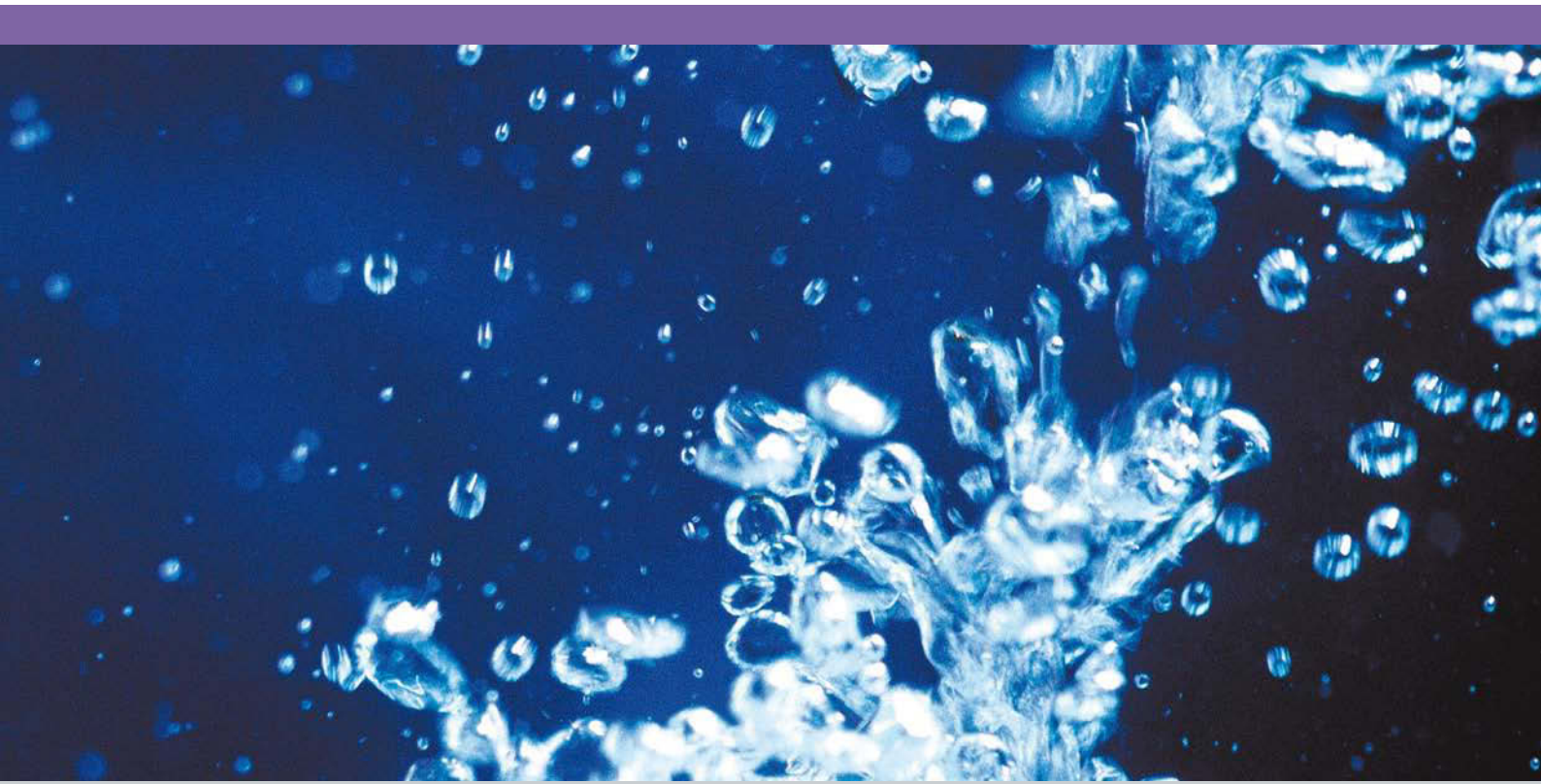
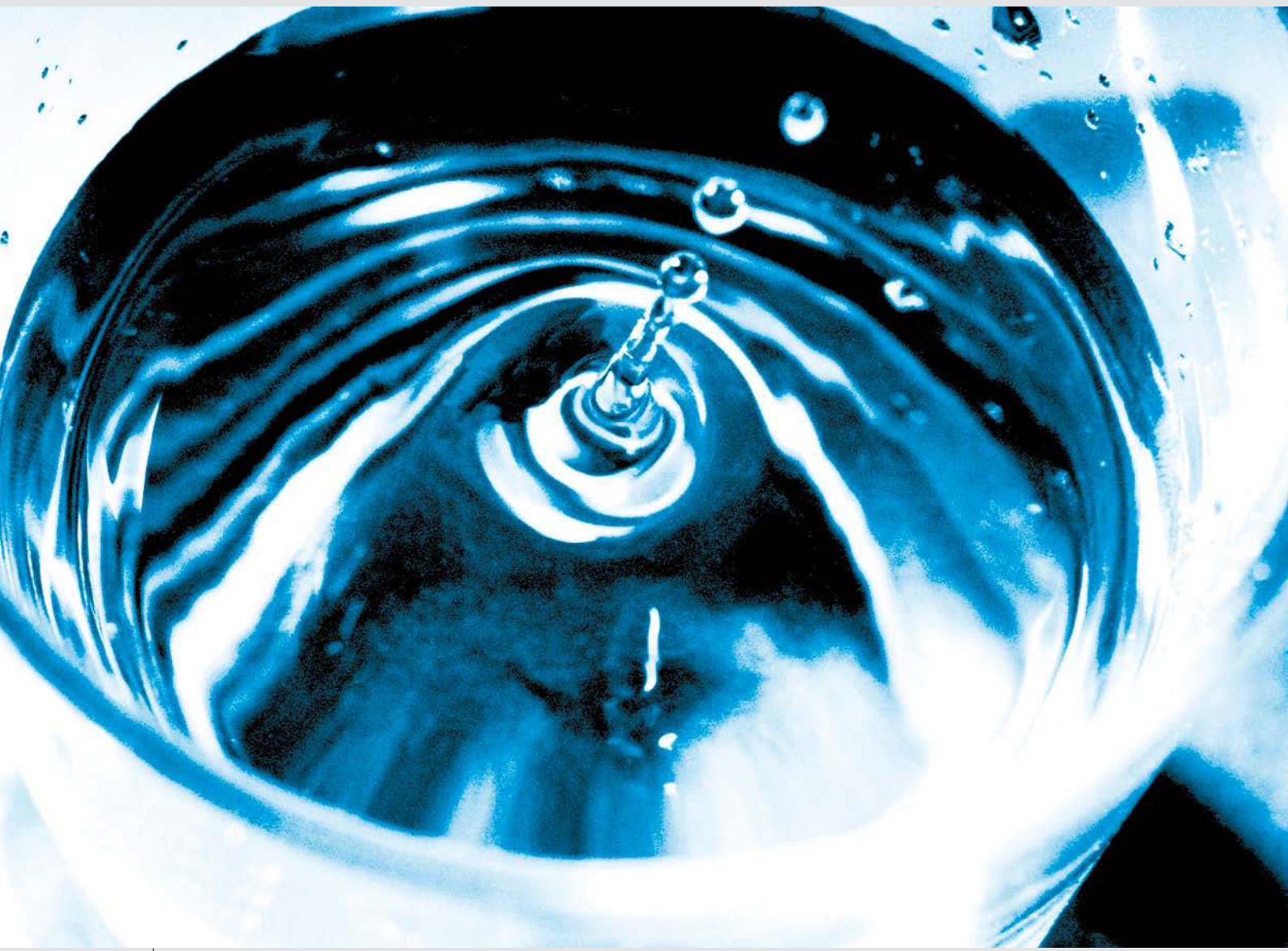

With more than 100 patents for technical inventions and registered designs, KESSEL possesses a wide range of patents for drainage technology.



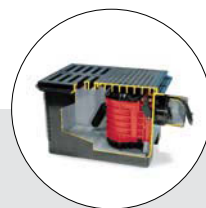


Drainage anywhere

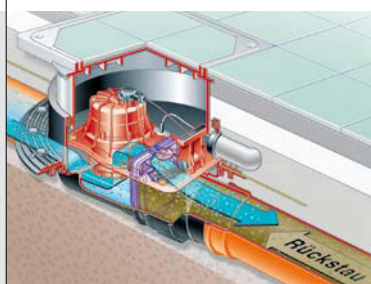

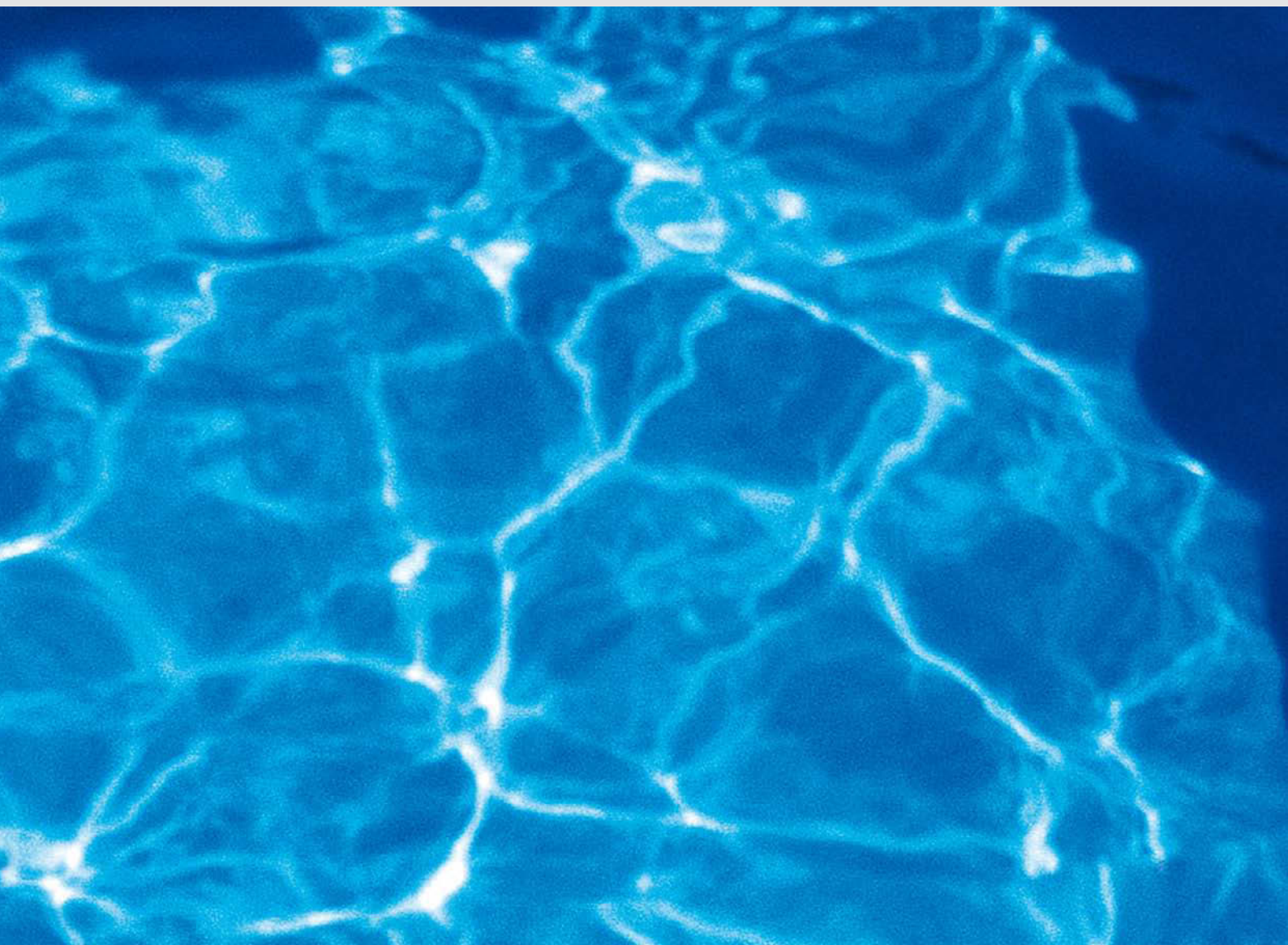
Pumping stations: safety to the fore

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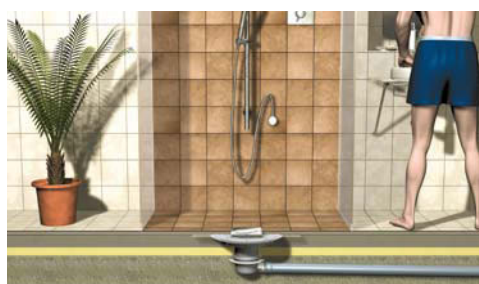

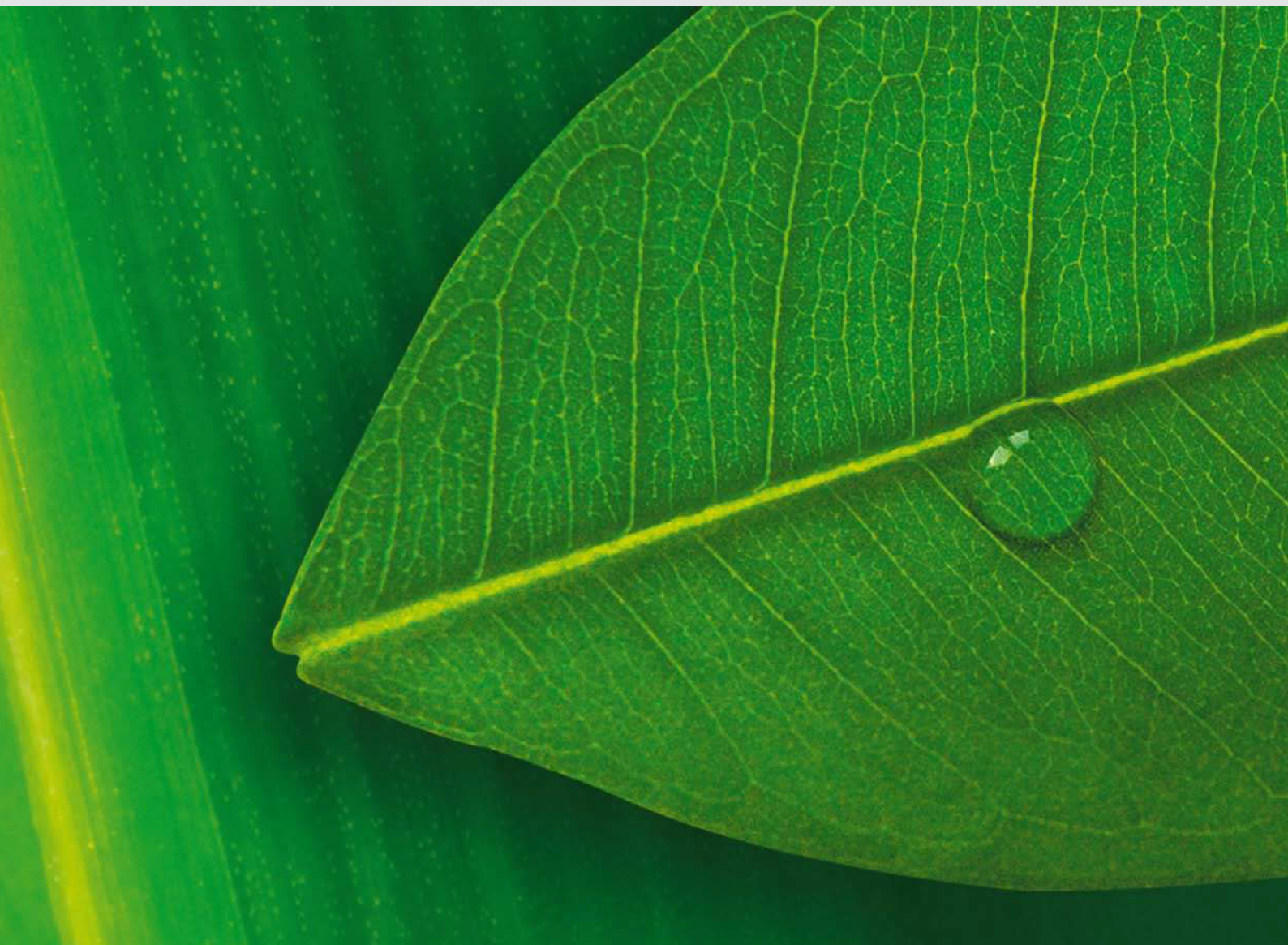

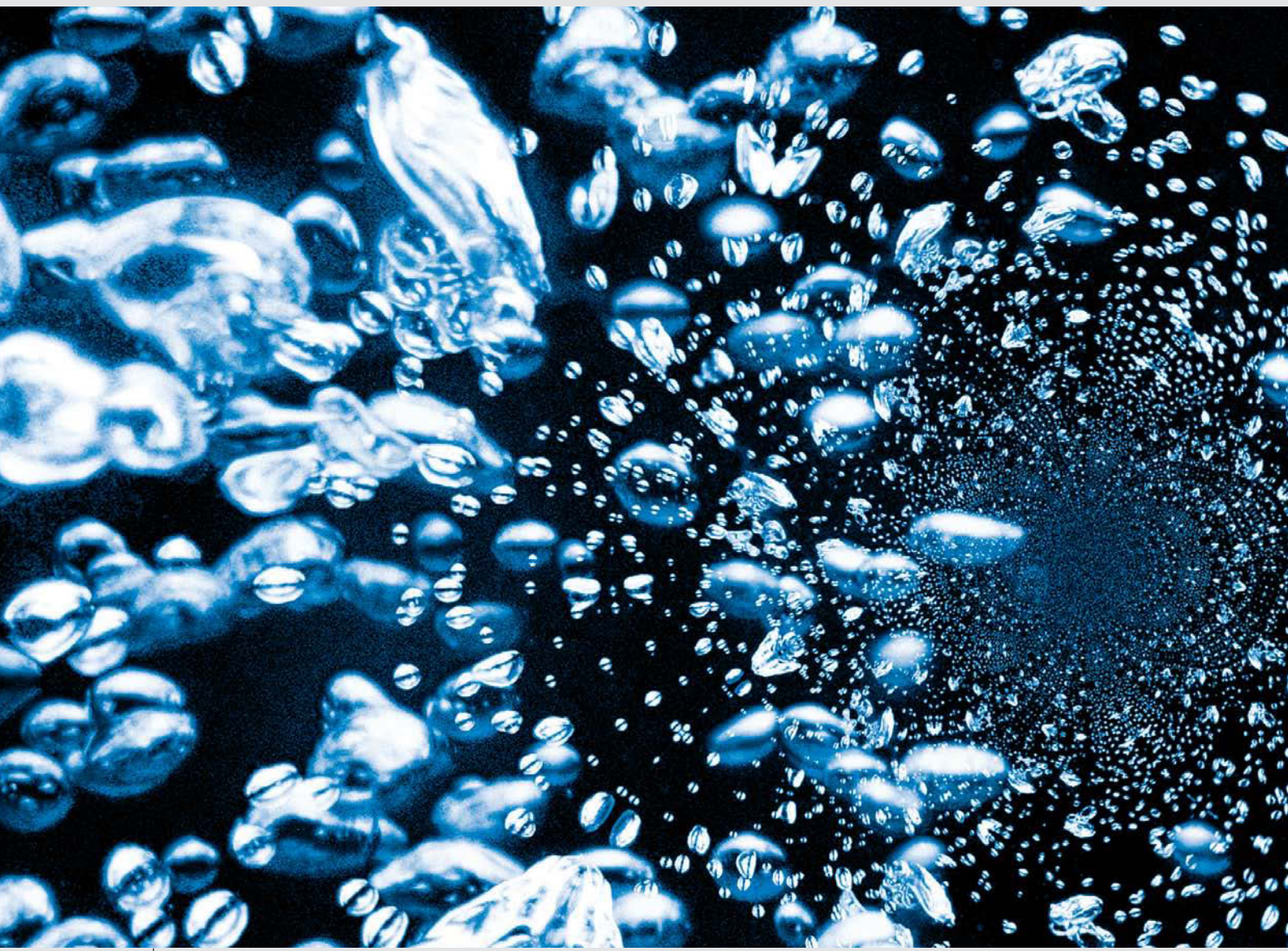

KESSEL separators ensure that wastewater pipes from commercial buildings as well as public sewers remain blockage free by removing greases and food wastes from wastewater streams. Regardless of the specification, we have either a standard product or a custom solution to handle the exact on-site requirements. KESSEL relies on the material polyethylene (PE) for the manufacture of these separation systems. This lightweight plastic offers the exact characteristics required for this application - easy installation, leak proof monolithic bodies, easy to clean surface and most important the material is 100% corrosion free.

In addition to grease separators, we also offer oil/fuel and coalescence separators. These are indispensable helpers everywhere where oil and fuel can occur. In this case as well, polyethylene materials ensure high-quality, comfort and safety while working.

KESSEL septic systems for wastewater treatment

KESSEL septic systems help in cleaning domestic waste water even in areas without sewage systems. KESSEL has developed a particularly economic solution with the fully-biological INNO-CLEAN. This allows maintenance costs and power consumption to be reduced to a minimum. It is particularly practical for building clients. The shatterproof and light units made of polyethylene can also be installed without using a crane.

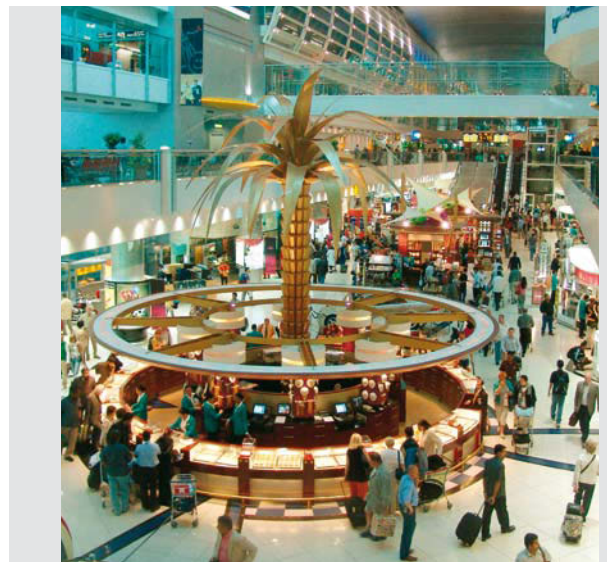




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International flight hub of the Middle East: Dubai International Airport

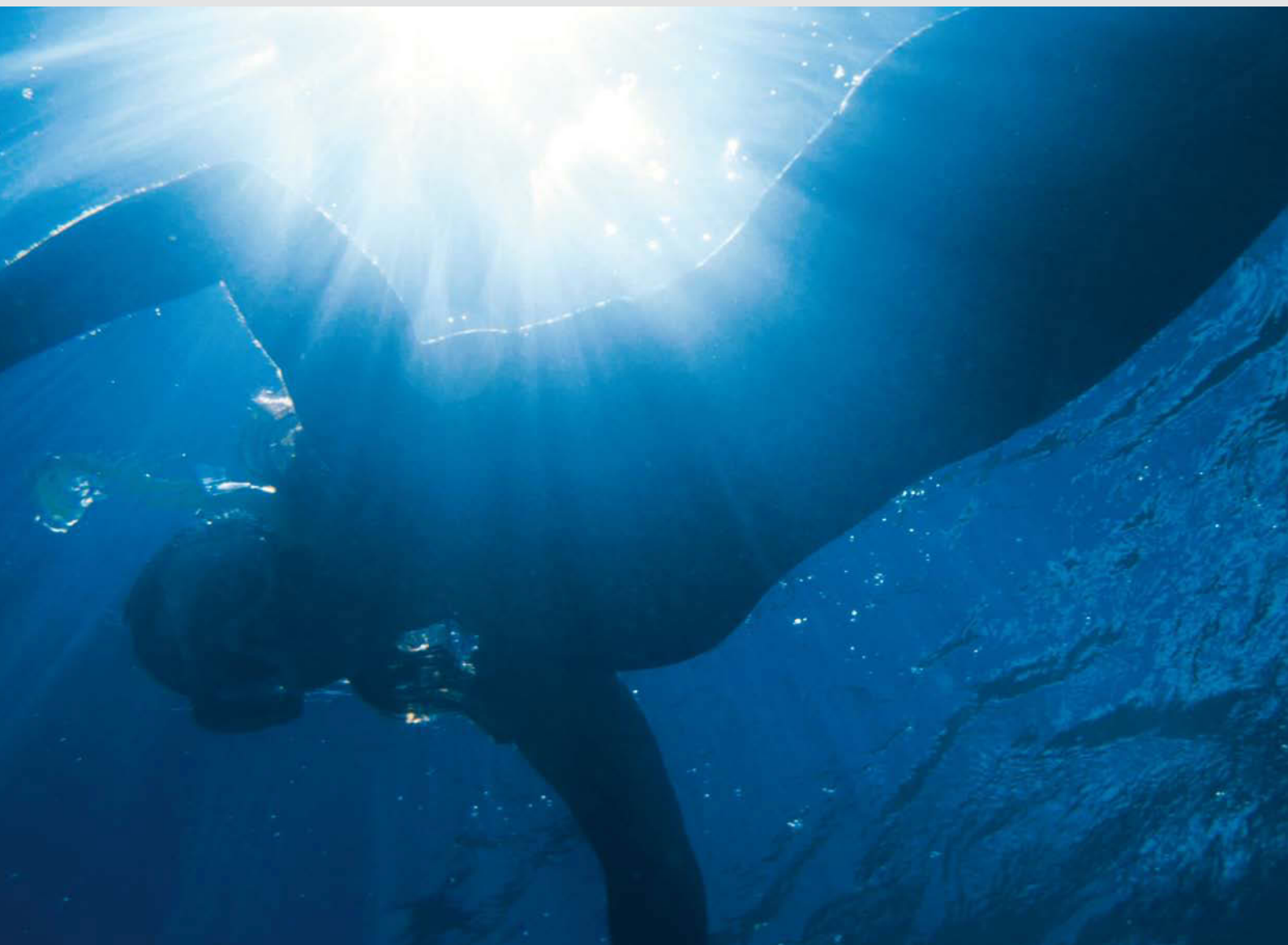

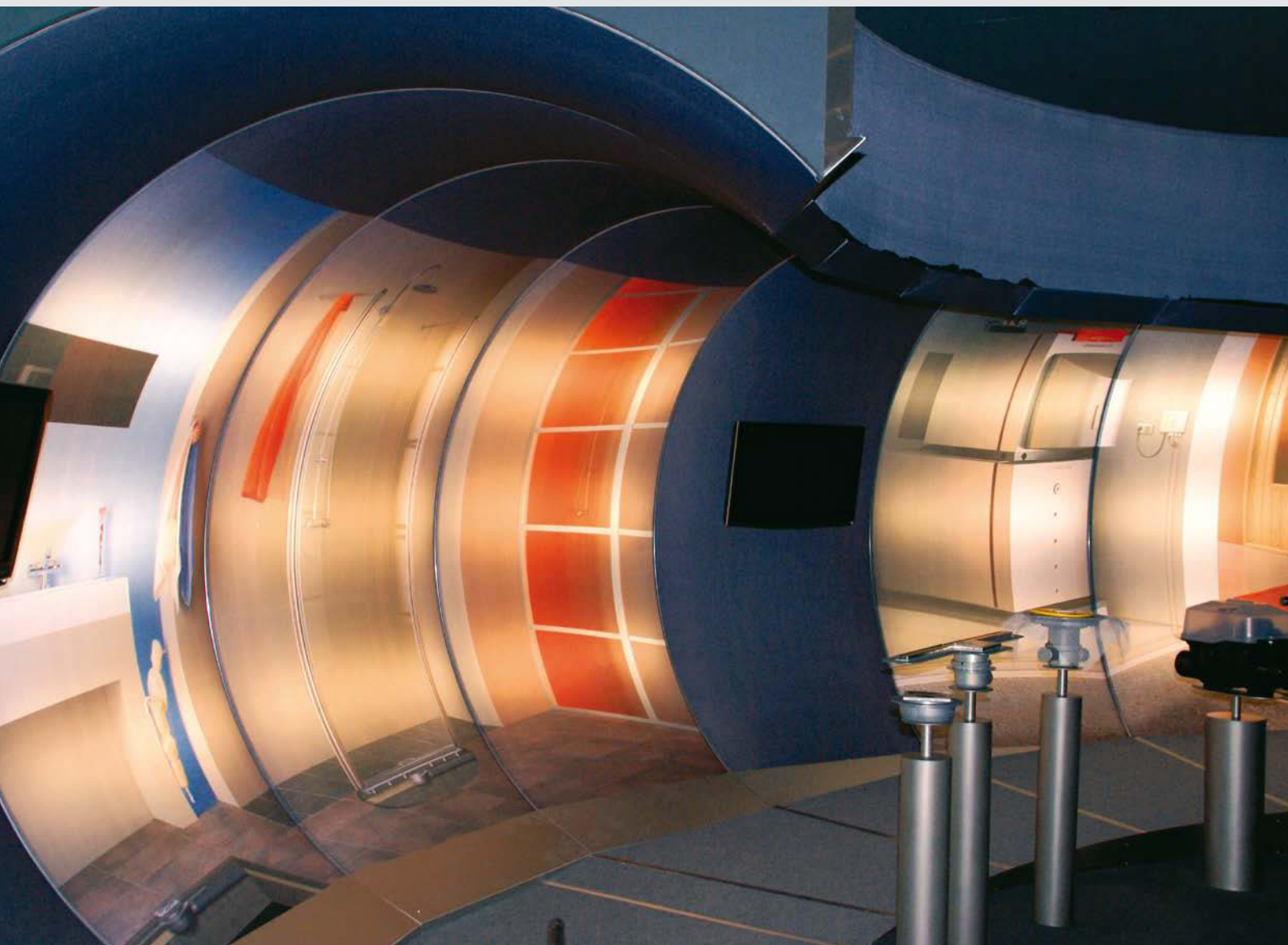
